CATCHER STRATEGY

You know the catcher renaissance that I was going on about last year? Yeeeeeah ... it didn't happen.

True, William Contreras reiterated his elite standing, and Yainer Diaz and Cal Raleigh further established their bona fides. But Logan O'Hoppe, Francisco Alvarez, Gabriel Moreno, Bo Naylor, Luis Campusano and Henry Davis didn't break through as hoped, with three of them more or less removing themselves from Fantasy consideration. Meanwhile, mainstays like Adley Rutschman, Will Smith and J.T. Realmuto all took a step back, putting their draft standing in a precarious spot. It's not a great situation.

So if the outlook at catcher has reversed from a year ago, when I advised you to wait at the position, am I advising you to pounce now? Not really.

I mean, you can if the value is right. The thinning out at catcher presents an opportunity to create some daylight between you and the opposition, which wasn't so true last year, and particularly in leagues with smaller lineups, like standard Head-to-Head, you need to find whatever daylight you can. But it's still a brutal position to play, leading to a high attrition rate and performance instability. And that's not even accounting for the playing-time concerns inherent to the position. Why do you think so much went wrong last year?

So what's my plan, then? Basically, last year served to remind me that the juice isn't worth the squeeze at catcher if the value isn't right. I may be a little more intentional about drafting it in those smaller-lineup leagues, like Head-to-Head, but that's really only true for these first two ...

FIRST BASE STRATEGY

What ... the heck? First base is supposed to be big and beautiful, just a treasure trove of sluggers, but that's not what I'm seeing now. In fact, I regret to report that only four first basemen had 30-plus homers last year, and the leader, Pete Alonso, had just 34. The last time the home run leader at first base had so few was 2012.

You're not getting base-stealers at first base, obviously, so suffice it to say the position is as thin as it's been in a long time, a product of some of the mainstays getting older and some of the newcomers not living up to their potential yet. And while prospects like Nick Kurtz, Bryce Eldridge, and Jac Caglianone represent hope for the future, we're stuck with the same old cast of characters for now.

So how do we make the most of it? That's something I'm still working through. I've found in early drafts that first base is the position where I'm most likely to get boxed out.

The studs at the position all go in quick succession, and the same is true for the mid-tier options, which means if you're not intentional about taking one, you're left to pick through the leftovers.

You might think, then, that I'd advise being intentional to avoid having a hole in your lineup from the get-go, but here's the thing ... even the quality first basemen don't feel as bankable as they have in the past. No position is deep, really -- maybe shortstop and outfield, up to a point -- so you'll never feel like you can skate at one. And if the increasingly scarce options at one position feel safer than the increasingly scarce options at first base, well, it stands to reason that you'll skip first base.

That's what I've been doing anyway, at least so far. Not in every draft, of course, and if timing works out, I certainly don't mind taking one of this first group ...

SECOND BASE STRATEGY

How stale has this position gotten? I said something similar about first base, that all the mainstays are getting older, but for how many years in a row now has the same trio of Jose Altuve, Ozzie Albies and Marcus Semien driven the conversation at second base? You get occasional pop-ins like Trea Turner that one time and Mookie Betts that other time, but it always comes back to those three. And after a year in which two of them failed to live up to expectations, you can hardly blame people for investing their dollars elsewhere.

But maybe the premise is faulty. After all, the consensus top second baseman heading into 2025 is someone else entirely: Ketel Marte, who also leads the position in OPS over the past four years. So where has he been all this time? Injured, partly, and also straining to regain our trust after notable misfires in 2020 and 2022. He has it for now, but he's also not exactly a breath of fresh air at age 31.

OK, but isn't Betts still in the second base mix? And wasn't Matt McLain closing the gap on the elites before missing last season with a shoulder injury? Believe it or not, neither one has second base eligibility heading

into 2025, and it's not clear how soon either will gain it. Betts is in line to play shortstop primarily, though that's not set in stone, and the Reds acquired Gavin Lux in the offseason, potentially signaling McLain's shift to the outfield. Both probably should be playing second base, but we have no assurances along those lines.

(We do, however, have assurances for Jazz Chisholm, another potential second base standout who currently isn't eligible at the position ... and who might just overtake Marte for the top spot when he is.)

Overall, second base is defined mostly by doubt, confusion and, yes, staleness. The ADP shows that people have checked out at the position, paying no mind to scarcity when deciding when to take the plunge. It would be one thing if there were a handful of surefire studs like we see at first base, but people don't trust that the old guys at second base are what they once were.

So even though second base is the weakest position (excluding catcher, which hardly counts as a position), it's not a particularly stressful one to draft. The prices for its best contributors are reasonable enough that I don't have to extend myself to get one.

THIRD BASE STRATEGY

Finally, we've arrived at a position that's ... not so terrible.

That's not a ringing endorsement, I know, and perhaps comes across as a touch ungrateful after what we just observed at first and second base. But while I acknowledge that third base shines over those two positions, it also isn't as strong as in years past.

Offense was down across the league in 2024, and the infield positions seem to have been hit the hardest. Either that or all the talent has gravitated toward shortstop, which has some literal truth to it. Elly De La Cruz and Gunnar Henderson, who were both eligible at third base last year, are both confined to shortstop now.

Without them, third base is once again headlined by a familiar foursome: Jose Ramirez, Rafael Devers, Austin Riley and Manny Machado. Jazz Chisholm has picked up eligibility there for the first time, and Mark Vientos and

Junior Caminero represent new blood in the position. There's promise for sure, but the assurances are few. If you do miss out on the elites, it's likely you'll be gambling to some degree.

And because so much of the position is a gamble anyway, I'm inclined to push things to their limit, forgoing flashier choices like Vientos and Caminero for an understated one later in the draft. There's one late-rounder in particular who would seem to have impact potential, if not quite stud upside, and a fairly high probability of meeting it. Yes, what separates third base from every other position this year is that it's the one with a player whose price and outlook I like so much that I might just tailor my whole draft to him, at least if things don't break my way early.

How's that for a tease? Better keep reading!

You're probably noticing a trend with these position strategies: Every. Position. Stinks! I hate everything, and when you hate everything, you essentially hate nothing because, well, what sort of contrast can be drawn to your general state of being?

So maybe I'm just full of it, the kind of person who mistakes relentless negativity for having something to say. Whiny. Mopey. A sorry sack of a man.

Or maybe those other positions really are that bad.

I'm here to argue the latter (not surprisingly, since the alternative is that I'm a sorry sack of a man), and my evidence is this: I like what I see here. The shortest of stops is the longest in talent, and my soul leaps at the sight of it.

The studs here run eight deep. No other infield position has more than five. Even beyond the studs, there are

several players who have performed like studs in the recent past and, at least theoretically, could do it again.

I'm not going to say the talent goes on forever. If you're one of those high rollers who only plays in 15-team Rotisserie leagues, then there will come a point when you've waited too long to fill the position, as is true at every position. But if you're a normie who plays in reasonable-sized leagues with reasonable-minded people, then you're going to get a quality shortstop without even trying. You may even get a quality backup, too.

Of course, quality comes in different degrees, so if a good shortstop falls in my lap, I'm not pushing him off. But it's not a position that I'm putting much thought into, apart from a few particular value plays. (More on them in a bit.)

OUTFIELD STRATEGY

At this time a year ago, outfield was thought to be the scarcest position of all, which was doubly frustrating because it's also the one offensive position where, across all formats, multiple players are required. In a best-case scenario, it's three, but oftentimes, it's as many as five."

And so there was pressure to gobble up as many outfielders as you could stand early in drafts, recognizing that if you weren't deliberate about it, you'd be in for a nightmare scenario, particularly in those five-outfielder formats.

Now? It's not so bad. Between emerging studs like Jackson Chourio and Jackson Merrill and unexpected breakouts like Jarren Duran, Brenton Doyle, Lawrence Butler and Jurickson Profar, there's clearly enough talent to go around in a three-outfielder league. Even in a five-outfielder league, it's passable.

In fact, I'd say that, among hitter positions, only shortstop outshines outfield in terms of depth, and the same goes

for upside. Outfield is by nature a larger position than any singular infield spot, but it's still telling that six of the first 12 and 11 of the first 24 players drafted on average are outfielders. It so dominates the early stages of a draft that to avoid taking an elite outfielder would be to thread a needle.

So while I think as a general guideline, it makes sense to prioritize infield over outfield in 2025 drafts -- those positions are weaker on the whole, particularly first and second base -- I wouldn't say I'm dead set on it. In fact, my biggest takeaway as I work my way through these position strategy articles is how unintentional I am at every position. This player pool is just the perfect storm of depth and scarcity misalignment, making the ideal path unique to each particular draft.

I know that may be disorienting after so many years of me driving home the need to draft one position or another early, but embrace the freedom, I guess.

STARTING PITCHER STRATEGY

Remember The Glob? That's the term I used to describe the talent distribution at starting pitcher a year ago: just a couple dozen difference-makers and then an indiscernible mass of mediocrity. Once you entered The Glob, there was no point in playing favorites. You could only hope you had the bulk of your pitching staff assembled already.

After the juiced ball era had us selling out for aces, the Well, I'm here to tell you The Glob is no more. It was a one-year phenomenon -- full of sound and fury, signifying nothing -- and now the pendulum has swung back the other way. It's swung back so hard, in fact, that we're basically working with the reciprocal now -- a Good Glob, you might even say.

Loosely, I've described it as 15-50 in my rankings. It's actually more like 15-47, and by the time you read this, injuries may have reduced the range further. But the point is that it's again a large, indistinguishable mass, only this time comprised of pitchers that are, you know, talented. Not all of them will pan out, of course -- such is the nature of pitching -- but from where things stand now, their outlooks are so similar that I hesitate even to rank them. What looks right to me one day looks upside-down to me the next. Truth is I only do it because they make me.

"So wait, you're saying that entire span of pitchers, roughly 15 through 50 in your rankings, is interchangeable?" Yeah, pretty much. If you really pin me down, I could divide it into two groups -- those who could potentially suffice as aces and those who likely won't -- and if you check out my starting pitcher tiers, you'll see I've marked that distinction with "start of good glob" and "end of good glob". But it's a fine line that I'd just as soon ignore on Draft Day. I mean, Bailey Ober is in one group and Joe Ryan in the other, yet they both profile as fly-ball pitchers with elite control and above-average strikeout potential -- and for the same team, no less. I'm splitting

hairs between the two, yet they're 11 spots apart in my rankings.

The middle tier at this position is of such depth, such quality and, to put a finer point on it, such redundancy that I don't know why I'd invest in anyone high-end. Yet people do. The high-end pitcher is still better, they say, and that gives them an advantage. Yeah, maybe. But while the drop-off within the pitcher ranks is gradual, the drop-off within the hitter ranks is abrupt. (Remember me saying how bad every infield position is?) Plus, pitchers get hurt more, raising the possibility that the high-end investment turns out to be a bust. So if a position is riskier at the top and more forgiving in the middle, gee, what should you do?

In an ideal world, I'd take nothing but hitters with my first five or six picks, then I'd try scooping up as many of those Good Glob pitchers as I could, hopefully at least five but sometimes as many as six or seven. That's not to say I'd never deviate for a hitter, but I'd be feeling some urgency to fill out my pitching staff at that point. To me, casting a wide net among those mostly alike options is preferable to staking my whole season to an ace or two and then trying to patch up the rest of my lineup with inferior hitters. Sometimes I've even waited until Round 8 to take my first pitcher (in a shallower league, of course) and was happy with the result.

Of course, I don't live in an ideal world, so the approach I take depends somewhat on the way the draft is playing out. I still need good pitching, after all, and if I end up with only a couple top-50 options because I'm committed to a certain plan, well, that's a problem. But there's so much good to be found so deep into the pitcher rankings this year that I think you'd be foolish not to take advantage, particularly with so many of the hitter positions turning sour so quickly.

RELIEF PITCHER STRATEGY

We ended last season in a really nice place for closers. Lucas Erceg and Porter Hodge had emerged as lockdown options for the Royals and Cubs, respectively. Blake Treinen appeared to have a leg up for the Dodgers and Ben Joyce for the Angels. The trade deadline had thrown the relief pitcher position into chaos, but once the dust had settled, it sure seemed like the most talented reliever for each club had found his way into saves.

But then came the offseason and a series of moves that kicked up that dust again. Closers were by and large late to sign, and then when they did, it was with teams that seemingly had a closer already, muddying what had been clear waters.

So are we still in a nice place? Look, it's been worse. The closer committee craze has died down a bit from its peak, with only a handful of managers showing a real fondness for it. But even so, I don't feel like roles are as settled as at this time a year ago.

It doesn't really change my approach to the relief pitcher position. I'll never be the guy who pays top dollar for a top closer. But it does mean the bankable options deplete earlier, which may force me to react sooner than I'd like. Sometimes that depletion can happen so quickly that I don't even have a chance to react, so I find I'm anticipating more, trying to sniff out those closer runs before they begin. My goal is to secure a closer that, while not elite, is a reasonable enough bet to stay in the role all season and then pair him with a cheaper one who may invite a little more

skepticism. If I can land a third closer from that latter category, even better.

The approach is obviously geared more for a deeper Rotisserie league than, say, a standard Head-to-Head points league, where not every closer is likely to be drafted. In those shallower formats, I pretty much wait until the end of the draft to take mine. Even if they're not the greatest, there won't be much competition for whatever newcomer closers inevitably emerge on the waiver wire.

By now, some of you are probably screaming what about saves-plus-hold leagues!?! (Saves-plus-holds-leaguers aren't quiet about it, in my experience.) And my advice to them is ... take however many saves-plus-holds sources you think you need. You can probably wait until the end of your draft to do it because it's not like your league is going to run out. There's a higher margin for error, too, because if a saves guy becomes a holds guy or a holds guy becomes a saves guy, well, it's all going into the same bucket. You may think it's more complicated than that, but it really isn't. In fact, the whole point of going the saves-plus-holds route is to eliminate the relief pitcher complication. So, like ... don't complicate it. As long as you're engaged enough to nurture your saves-plus-holds supply throughout the season and not just go on autopilot after the draft, you'll be fine.

End of rant. Time to name names.
